The following, thought-provoking article was written by one of my preaching colleagues from back east, Steve Higgenbotham. It gets right to the heart of the question, which perhaps is a question of the heart.

It is no secret that Sunday night attendance dips by more than 50 percent compared to Sunday morning. I realize that some of you *cannot* get back on Sunday nights (distance, transportation issues, don't get out at night, etc.). But I also know that *many* of you will choose not to come back. Carefully consider Steve's article. I pray sincerely that I will see you back tonight, not because you *have* to come, but because you *want* to be here. Until we meet again (hopefully this afternoon at 5:00)...TWP

Through the years, I have often had people ask me the question, "Do I have to go to *all* the services of the church? I mean, what if I don't go on Sunday night?" Well, allow me to answer that question with a few questions of my own.

- Do you *have* to hug and kiss your little children?
- Do you *have* to remember your wife's birthday?
- Do you *have* to call home when you're late coming home from work?
- Do you *have* to buy Christmas presents for your family?
- Do you *have* to attend ball games and band functions when your kids are involved?
- Do you *have* to attend the funeral of a close friend or loved one?
- Do you *have* to say, "I love you" when you love someone?

I think you see the point. Sometimes we are guilty of asking the wrong questions. There are some things in life that we don't "have" to do, but we "get" to do. In fact, even asking the question, "Do I have to?" is terribly inappropriate.

When my relationship with God is based on what I *have* to do and what I don't *have* to do, then I had better take a long hard look at that relationship.
