TIM TALK

As the old expression says, "Spring is in the air." As nature (and people, too) begins to stretch and awaken from the winter, it seems to quicken our activities and fill our calendars as well. If your family is anything like ours, most days and nights are scheduled to the brim, causing us to be constantly on the run. But there is something that is just around the corner that I hope you will use as the foundational building block of your time rather than an afterthought.

As you know by now, we have been studying on Sunday mornings how Jesus makes the difference in the lives of the people with who he has contact. While our overall theme of making a difference will continue, we will shift our sermon focus on Sunday mornings to the theme, "The Word Makes the Difference." I mentioned this to you earlier, but we - as a congregation - are going to undertake to read the bible through in just 90 days. Perhaps you have attempted reading it through in a year, but got bogged down about three months in with all the Levitical laws. This 90 day reading plan is a fast-moving way to read the entire Bible, without a lot of time built in for intense study. This will be my second time to go through this program. What I heard from most people the last time was how, for the first time, the "dots" of the big picture were connected. Many said it was easy for them to see the thread of God's redemptive plan from start to finish. It will require from 30 minutes to an hour of your day (depending on your reading speed). It may require you to turn off the TV, or maybe get out of bed a little earlier each day. You might download an audio bible and listen on your mp3 player to and from work or in the gym. You might even want to go ahead and start today to get a jump-start on the reading. There were some kids as young as 12 who completed this the last time, so I know you can do it!

Even if you are already reading the bible daily, I challenge you to get on board with this, and let the Word make a daily difference in your life. Let God's message to you become such an integral part of your day that, if you don't read it, your day is incomplete.

I will be preaching lessons that will follow the week's reading. I will also be using our Facebook page to keep up with who is reading and perhaps some daily discussion of the text. I will have the reading schedules (which will start April 1) on the welcome center Sunday. Please take one (or more as needed) and commit to this reading schedule with me. It WILL make a difference in your life! Until we meet again...TWP
