TIM TALK

At the risk of coming off as an advertisement, I want to share with you an opportunity to support deployed soldiers and sailors with the Word of God. I first learned of this effort last year and my family chose to get involved in this unique ministry effort. *Faith Comes By Hearing* is a company whose aim is to get audio bibles to as many people in as many languages as possible. A recent language survey found that there are 6,809 languages spoken in our world today. FCBH currently has recorded the New Testament in 525 of those, making the Word available in audio format for more than 5 billion people in 185 different countries. Their goal is to record in 2,000 languages by the year 2016, which will introduce Christ via mp3 format to 97% of the world's population. They want to do this in audio format because 50% of people in the world are illiterate.

On their website, the company describes their effort to get these audio bibles into the hands of our men and women in the military. "Last year, FCBH felt burdened to bring the Word of God in audio to our nation's military community. So, we developed a specialized, portable audio player just for their use - camouflaged and loaded with the entire [...] New Testament - and sent it to those who are deployed or deploying." This particular mp3 player was designed with the needs of our servicemen in mind. "With a matte black finish, matte black ear buds and a red-light-only operation, the Military BibleStick has an intentional low-key design to reduce visibility and to be used in low-light situations. This Audio Bible, which is about the size of a pack of chewing gum, easily fits into a uniform pocket and is rugged enough to withstand unpredictable weather." It is encouraging to read the testimonies of soldiers and sailors who have returned from deployments and been impacted by God through the use of these recordings (the English is recorded from the English Standard Version, by the way).

The only issue right now is that requests from military chaplains has outpaced the supply of these BibleSticks. If you wish to sponsor one of these, the cost is \$25. When the BibleStick is delivered, it also includes a response card so that the soldier's family can receive the same audio recordings at no cost to them. There are even children's versions available. So when you choose to participate in this program, you not only bless the individuals in the military but their families back home as well. If you want more information, please contact me and I will send you in the right direction. What better way to support our men and women in uniform than by putting the Word of God in their hands...and ears! Will you get involved?
