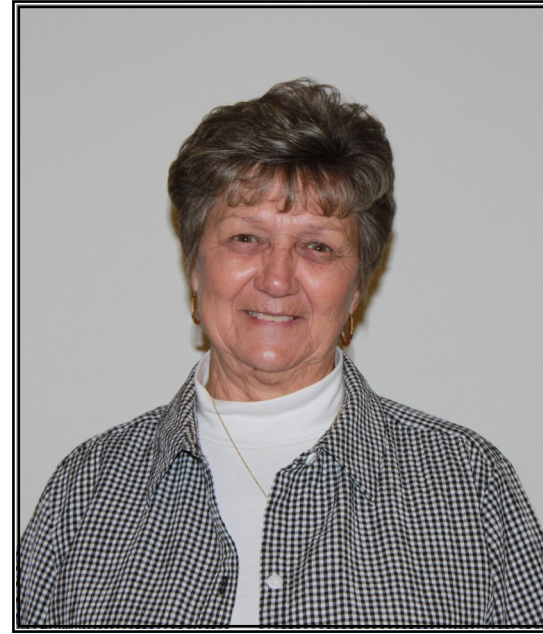
Betty Richardson— Prayers for my grandson, Matthew, he needs a lot of prayers.

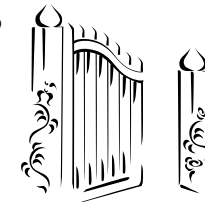
Shirley Smith
