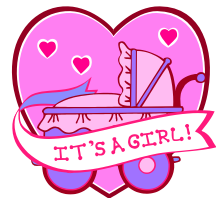

## TIM TALK

In Disney's *The Lion King*, we learned to call it "The Circle of Life." We see it in coming and going, in birth and burial, in literal life and death. Even the youngest among us understand that these two events are the bookends of our existence on earth. The Woodward Park family has recently been touched with the excitement of new births. With baby showers happening often we anticipate more sweet cries to soon be heard in worship. And we have also dealt with the pain of death and loss. Because we know that there are others among us who are sick, whose bodies are wearing out, and doubtless we will attend more memorial services. But this is only a shadow of the circle of spiritual life that we witnessed this week.

Wednesday night, I had the privilege of baptizing Nate and Liz Sabala and watched Thien Dang baptize his sister Tram. And I was reminded of the spiritual circle of life. We go from life to death and back to life again. Then to death, and finally life. We are born into life, but as we live and experience sin, it brings death to our souls. When we are then united with the death of Christ, dying to self we come into a new life. Once our physical death occurs, we step into eternal life. As final as death may seem, we must constantly remind ourselves that the blood of Jesus' death applied to our lives here will make our death but an entrance into life (Romans 6, 1 Thessalonians 4, John 11).

Perhaps it sounds a bit confusing, but the spiritual Circle of Life is simply God's marvelous plan for saving us. That can indeed inspire some *Hakuna Matata* in all of us. Until we meet again...TWP
