"I Just Wish I Could Live My Life Over Again"

This is what Elijah, a six-year-old son of Jimmy and Trina Gee who are missionaries in Arusha, Tanzania, said while he and his brothers were enjoying their skateboard and skates on the smooth concrete. Thinking he was dissatisfied and wanted to change something, Trina asked what he would do differently. He enthusiastically responded, "Nothing! I just want to do it all over again!" Now that's the way to live life!

But, the older we get the more we would like to live life over because there are some things we'd like to change. God enables that to happen. Paul reminds us, "Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come" (2 Corinthians 5:17). Being immersed in water for the forgiveness of sins puts one into Christ (Acts 2:38; Romans 6:3-4). When one submits to Christ, by confessing His name before men and is baptized, the past life is gone. Your new life begins. That is why Jesus described this event as being born again to Nicodemus in John 3:1-8. Would you like to live your life over again? Let us assist you with that.

But, when we get that new life we will not live it perfectly either, but God has an answer for that also. He said, "If we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:7-9). Thus, for those who are Christians, they continue to have a new life by walking in the light of God's word and confessing their sin to ask God for His forgiveness.

Then when our life is ended we will be welcomed home where "He who sits on the throne said, 'Behold, I am making all things new'" (Revelation 21:5). Everything will be right in the place He has gone to prepare for us (John 14:1-3). Do you want to live your life over? You can. Let us assist you.
