Last week was a very busy one for my family. I traveled around 6,000 miles between Sundays. At the beginning of the week I was near the West Coast, visiting the Reagan Library with the Senior Saints, but by week's end I was on the East Coast for my nephew's graduation. We were fortunate to fly cross-country during the middle of the day, and it was amazing to watch the country beneath change. From snow on the Sierras to desert to snow on the Rockies to windfarms in the flat Midwest to the green fields and forests east of the Mississippi...this country is so geographically diverse.
