Dear Church Family,
Thank you for all of the prayers. We went to Kaiser Redwood City, on the 1st for consultation. We didn't even make the freeway before the doctor called and ask us to come back and have a Cat Scan and head X-Rays.

They got me to surgery at 6 pm. The surgery was to close the skin on my head. During surgery the doctors removed as much of the plates, screws and anything else they could because they found E. Coli and a form of Staff infection on the bone and the hardware used in previous surgeries. Upon returning home I had to see the Infectious Disease doctor on 10/7. They inserted a picc line. I will be on this for 28 days.

The good news is I am responding to the oral and IV anti-biotic. I may have to have surgeries in the future. Please continue to pray for me and my family.
