TIM TALK

Have you ever found yourself facing something that
seemed impossible? Perhaps it was a sickness or a
spiritual struggle or something entirely different; but
when you opened your eyes, what you saw terrified you.
You knew that there was no escape. What did you do?
How did you respond? Consider the following men and
women who have been there:

Hagar, a single mom, was forced into the desert with
her boy to die of thirst.

Joseph, wanting to fulfill divine dreams, was seized,
stripped, sold as a slave and imprisoned in Egypt.

David, being anointed by Samuel, was pursued by Isra-
elite troops.

Hezekiah, seeking revival, was trapped by the most
powerful army on earth, bent on annihilating his people.

The apostles, trying to preach this Crucified One, were
horsewhipped.

Peter would later write: "Beloved, do not be surprised at
the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for
testing, as though some strange thing were happening
to you" (1 Peter 4.12). I love the way Peterson renders
that passage: "Friends, when life gets really diffi-
cult, don't jump to the conclusion that God isn't
on the job. Instead, be glad that you are in the
very thick of what Christ experienced. This is a
spiritual refining process, with glory just around
the corner."

When it seems we are about to be overwhelmed,
we should remember the words of Jesus in John
16.33: "Here on earth you will have many trials
and sorrows. But take heart, because **I have
overcome the world.**"

Facing a "Red Sea" in your life? Can't see a way
out? Put all your trust in the ultimate way-maker
- GOD! As the old hymn says: "Ask the savior to
help you, comfort, strengthen and keep you. He
is willing to aid you. He'll carry you through."
