It's no secret that many people in our state are focused on the Giants and their battle with the Rangers for baseball glory. I thought it would be appropriate to share with you the following story (author unknown to me) from my files.

The great Babe Ruth hit 714 home runs during his baseball career. In 1921, his contemporary Tris Speaker made the statement that Ruth made a mistake to stop pitching and focus on hitting. Babe answered by hitting 59 home runs that season, and then hitting 60 just a few seasons later.

But not every game was a gem for the Babe. During one of his last games as a professional, the aging Ruth fumbled the ball several times. In fact, his errors alone allowed the opposing team to score 5 runs...in just one inning!

As the Babe walked off the field and headed toward the dugout after the dreadful inning finally ended, a crescendo of derisive yelling and booing reached his ears. It was humiliating moment for that great athlete who had been the number one idol of baseball fans for so many years.

Just then, a boy jumped over the railing onto the playing field. With tears streaming down his face, he knelt before his hero and threw his arms around his legs.

Ruth didn't hesitate for a second. He took the boy's hand and lifted him up. He hugged him, then set him on his feet, patting him gently on the head.

The noise from the stands came to an abrupt end. Suddenly there was no more booing. In fact, a hush fell over the entire ballpark. The Babe and the boy had melted the hearts of the crowd.

I am reminded of the words of Paul in 2 Corinthians 1.3-5: "All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is our merciful Father and the source of all comfort. He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us. For the more we suffer for Christ, the more God will shower us with his comfort through Christ."
