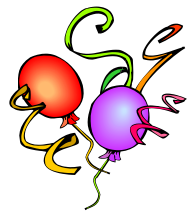

TIM TALK

Unless you have been absent for the last two weeks, you have heard me talking about one word a lot: WEIRD. I have shared with you two lessons on becoming the "God kind of weird" and on why it is *better* to be weird. But someone came to me Sunday with this comment: "I am having a hard time making myself believe that *weird* is what I am supposed to be." This brother went on to relate different images that came to his mind when he heard the word "weird," most of which were unpleasant and undesirable. Because those were the things he had associated with weirdness, he just couldn't make himself think that weird was the right thing to be.

Two things occurred to me. First, if he feels that way, it was likely that others do, too. Thus we need to address the issue. Second, I realized what was at issue was a matter of semantics. We had ourselves a classic word communication problem. So how do we fix this, so that the next few weeks of "weird" preaching (no smart remarks, please!) don't push folks away? I think the answer is to re-define weird.

Instead of thinking in terms of being a weirdo, we think in terms of being *different*. Instead of thinking strange, we think in terms of *holy*. Instead of going along with the crowd, we think in terms of *being a light to the world*. That is the essence of the God kind of weird.

Perhaps, though, we would be better to simply hear from God's word regarding what it will be like to be weird for the Lord:

If the world hates you, remember that it hated me first. The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but you are no longer part of the world. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you. Do you remember what I told you? 'A slave is not greater than the master.' Since they persecuted me, naturally they will persecute you. And if they had listened to me, they would listen to you. They will do all this to you because of me, for they have rejected the One who sent me. (John 15:18-21)

Jesus told us explicitly that following him was not only weird, it would be noticeable. Being noticeable would inevitably bring consequences. Those would not always be pleasant. And then he said in Matthew 5 that our reward in heaven is greater because of this kind of treatment. That is some weird thinking! But remember, weird people don't think like normal people think. Until we meet again...TWP
