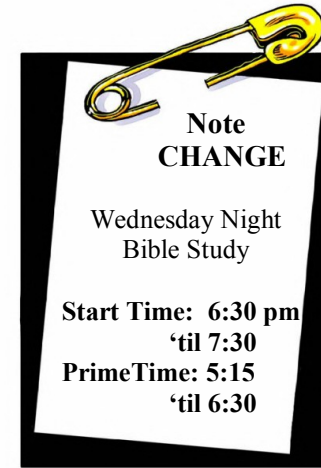

We want to thank the church for your loving concern and for the prayers on our behalf during this adoption process.

Here is the update about our adoption journey:

I-600A forms have been submitted. These are forms to the U.S. about us, to verify that we are able to adopt a child.

Dossier is almost complete. This is documentation similar to the I-600A listed above but for the Haitian government. Once completed this is submitted to the Haitian Consulate in Chicago for approval. After this it's given to the IBESR in Haiti.

Haitian Lawyer, Ronel, is working on getting documents in order to show that Johnson is available for adoption (i.e. he meets the definition of orphan). This in my estimation is the most difficult portion of this journey. It's handled outside of my “oversight”. Johnson has been “abandoned” by both of his parents for different reasons, father for poverty and health issues and mother since infancy “just because”. Because he has 2 surviving parents it makes it very hard to prove “orphan status”.

This will not be an easy task but it is our hope that through much prayer our God will grant us this privilege of adopting this child. Please let all know that this is the case.
