## TIM TALK

If you have been here at all over the last few weeks, you know that I have been working to push us toward a truer, more Jesus-oriented discipleship. We have taken a very sober look at the demands of following Jesus, and I hope that it has caused you to spend time in the Word and in prayer about your own walk.

Too often, Christians buy into a “cheap grace” type theology, which promises all the benefits of salvation and being in Christ without requiring anything of those professing to be saved. I hope you have seen that the truth is very different. I hope that you are convinced that living for Jesus is something very different, much deeper. In fact, I hope you have come through our study so far with two things: a truer picture of what discipleship looks like, and a greater desire to live that out in everyday life. Jesus warned us that such a life would not be easy, and would be met with resistance. That resistance may come subtly, or it may be blown up in your face; either way, it comes from Satan. He does not want you to follow Jesus. He does not want you to see the lost and share the gospel. And anyone or anything that gets in our way of doing that is surely a tool of his.

For football fans, today is the big one. The Patriots will square off against the Giants, in a game that is estimated to be viewed by more than 100 million people. As of Thursday, there were still tickets available on 40-yard-line in row 1. Of course, those seats would have cost you \$11,650 each...what a bargain!

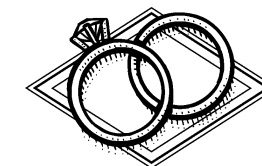
