not worshipping with you.

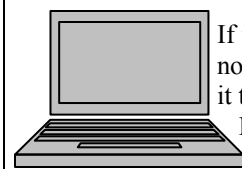
Tom Higham is in Kaiser, Rm 438 with pneumonia and congestive heart

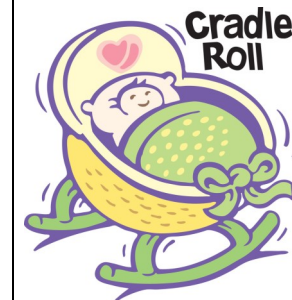
