Cheryl Rowe—Pray for me to patient with everyone I come into contact with. Thank you. I love you all.

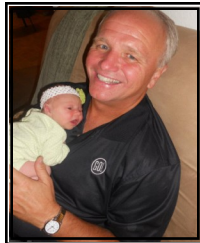

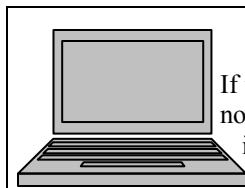

This is an exciting week for our church family. We have the treat of having Keith Parker with us for a few days. Most of you know that Keith is Ashley Frizzell’s father (which now means he is Pa Pa to Eden). And most of you were here when Keith worked as Woodward Park’s interim Preaching Minister (in early 2010). But what makes these days is even more exciting is Keith’s passion for preaching the saving Gospel of Jesus.

I have been privileged to know Keith for several years. He was a tremendous influence on my preaching life as a “boy preacher.” I will never forget times that he prayed with me. Of all the preachers I know, he is easily one of my favorites.

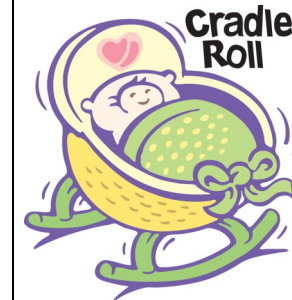
