Church Starts Early with Service Projects

The Grapevine Church of Christ, a 440-member congregation in the Dallas-Ft. Worth metroplex, has begun a program to instill the enjoyment of service in their young children. Called Helping Hearted Children (HHC), the two-year olds through kindergarten classes do a service project at least once a month. The children began this program late in 2012 by decorating bags and filling them with grocery items for Christ Haven Children's Home. For this service, the children dressed up in their Helping Hands t-shirts and carried the bags to the front of the auditorium to place them with bags brought by others the congregation.

The next project, Bears on Patrol, done on November 18, was done in connection with Officer Rich Savage and the Grapevine Police Department. The children collected forty-five teddy bears and gave them to officers to carry in their cars so they would have them readily available when they find themselves needing to comfort a hurting child.

On December 9, the children worked with their families to help the Grapevine Police Department Santa Cops program in wrapping Christmas gifts for needy children in the Grapevine community.

On January 13, the children decorated and gave away jars of Hot Cocoa mix to members of the Grapevine congregation to show their love for others in the church family.

Their February project is "Sock It To Me." an effort to collect 500 pairs of men's socks to be donated to the Main Street Church of Christ in Dallas to help in their effort with the homeless.

In March, the HHC children will be collecting DVDs to donate to Ronald McDonald house and in April they will be preparing "Love Baskets" for the shut-in members of the Grapevine family.

Mary Harris directs this program which recognizes the importance of starting early with the type of conduct we want our young people to demonstrate. There is a true joy in serving and for children to experience that joy early in life can make an indelible impression. The example of these very young children has influenced other members to participate with them in their projects. Sow the seeds early!!!
