TIM TALK

We were blessed last week to hear lessons from God's word preached by Keith Parker. Keith's messages centered around the subject of "Saved or Lost." The following column is adapted from one by Alan Webster, a preacher from Jacksonville, Alabama, who serves as editor of "House to House, Heart to Heart." It captures the thought I want you to think about now that meeting has ended. If you will, it answers the question of where we go from here with an action plan.

Continue in the Things You Have Learned ([2 Timothy 3.14](#)).

The lessons presented were Scriptural and therefore demand not only our hearing but our obedience ([James 1.22](#)). Since our desire is not to be hypocrites, we must first live what we learn ([Matthew 7.3-5](#)). Look back over your notes. Go to the website or get CDs and listen to the sermons again, meditating upon the truths presented. All of us can be challenged to a deeper understanding and commitment. Lived lessons last longer.

Visit the Visitors Especially on Sunday morning, there were lots of new faces in attendance. We should follow up with those who visited, and let them know how thankful we are that they came. As opportunities present themselves, we should ask if they have questions about what the preacher said. We should try to set up a study and explain how to become one of His children ([Galatians 3.26-27](#)). This may be a good time to invite them to come back and join a Bible class, especially if they have children. If you want to get involved teaching those who visit, talk to Joe Boe or JD Nix, and they will get you plugged in to our personal evangelism efforts. "He who wins souls is wise" ([Proverbs 11.30](#)).

Don't Lose Heart In Doing Good ([Galatians 6.9](#)). The devil certainly takes no days off ([1 Peter 5.8](#)); we cannot think that, since the Gospel was presented, we can just sit back and let God do the rest. Keith surely planted seeds that will need to be watered (1 Corinthians 3.6-7). The soil of our own hearts needs to be cultivated and fertilized, that God's word will grow and produce fruit in us (Matthew 13). We must continue to be God's hands and feet in the world around us, remembering that what we do for Him is never wasted (1 Corinthians 15.58).

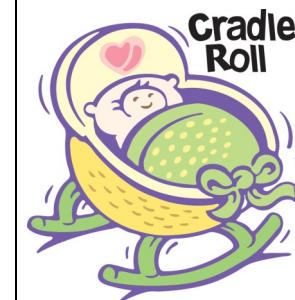
