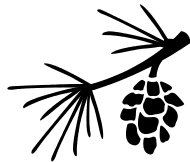

## Rooted And Grounded

The other day, we were walking along the popular Bob Jones Trail. As we were walking, I noticed that on the side of the hill to my right was a huge oak tree. The ground had eroded away exposing its roots. I have heard about their huge roots but I was amazed just how large the roots were. It was like seeing a tree's reflection in a lake. The root system was almost as big as the tree. The trees are short with huge limbs and trunk. The roots were as thick as the limbs. No wonder these trees stand firm under severe storms, and live a long time.

As I walked along the trail I began to think how God's word tells us to be "rooted and grounded." If we expect to stand firm regardless what life throws at us there needs to be more about us than what people can see. They may assume we are weak when we are meek, and they may think we are cowards because we are not easily provoked. They may assume we are weak because we don't brag about our victories.

Oh I held back from completing the biblical statement. It reads, "rooted and grounded in love" (Eph. 3:17). This is the key to victory over whatever Satan has to offer. When tribulations, trials, temptations, hard times, financial reversals, loss of jobs, loss of loved ones, loss of health come like a howling storm none of this will separate us from the love of God.

When we dig deep in God's word we become rooted and grounded. We learn that we love because God loved us first. We want to become more like the Lord so we grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Pet. 3:18).

We learn to love the unlovely because we are not too lovely ourselves. We are rooted and grounded in love so we will hold on to what we love: God's word, His church, His people, all people. We even love our enemies because once we were God's enemies (Rom. 5:10).

The next time you see a huge tree, remember it could never have survived without being "rooted and grounded." Ask yourself, "Am I rooted and grounded" to persevere to the end?
