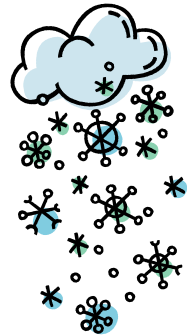

Get Busy and Have a Good Day

"We used to hold hands everywhere we walked. It didn't matter where we were, we held hands. My kids can still remember it after all these years."

"How long were you married before he passed away," I asked.

"Thirty-seven years. I'm ready to see him again. It won't be long now and I will see him."

"You mean ..." I started to speak but didn't know what to say after that.

"I'm 88 years old," she said with a smile and some laughter.

"You can't live forever. I should be seeing him soon."

I was visiting with a woman who works hard, loves her family, and rarely complains. At age 88 she walks slowly, and with a cane, but she always manages to go where she wants to and still does work around our church building. She was washing the communion trays as we were visiting together.

There was part of me that was feeling sympathy for her. But, I knew this Christian lady was not seeking sympathy. She was simply relating what she was thinking and feeling.

She went on: "I've been feeling strange lately. I've been thinking about him a lot."

"Sad?" I asked?

"Yes, sad," she replied, "especially through the holidays." Then she said something that characterized much of her life over the last 50 years. Reflecting on the strange feelings she's been having, the sadness, she said, "You just have to get busy and have a good day. That is what I do a lot."

Get busy and have a good day.

A good day is not just a matter of circumstances, or of our body chemistry at the moment, or the weather. A good day may be as basic as deciding that, no matter what our circumstances or how we feel, we can exercise some influence over how the next 24 hours plays out for us. A good day often comes down to a decision we consciously make that factors beyond our control will not be allowed to diminish the joy we can experience if we choose to.

Psalm 118:24 says, "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it." This statement appears in a chapter where the author writes about crying out in anguish, being surrounded by enemies, and even being chastened by the Lord. Yet, despite the challenges, the author never loses his faith and hope, and declares that he will give thanks and rejoice.

A good day is a choice. And my friend makes that choice every day. "Get busy and have a good day."

I left that conversation with her feeling uplifted. And I hope that by sharing it you will feel uplifted as well, with God's power for today.
