## TIM TALK

It is good to be back with you today! I was privileged to spend a few days with my parents in Tennessee to celebrate their 50<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary. The party itself was beautifully done, with mementos of various stages of their lives. It even included the dress that my mother wore on their first date and her wedding dress. The cake was an (almost) exact replica of their wedding cake, and featured the original cake topper. There were lots of friends and family members who joined in making this a very special day for my parents. It was a day tempered a bit with sad remembrance of the loss of both my brother and my sister, but we tried to keep the focus on happy memories and not grief.

I had the opportunity to speak for a few minutes at the party. It was a little difficult to know what to say. Of course, I wanted to congratulate them on fifty years of marriage; but it felt like there was something more that I ought to say. One word finally came to mind – legacy. If you look the word up in most dictionaries, the first definition usually has to do with money, or an estate. However, the meaning I had more in mind was “something transmitted by or received from an ancestor or predecessor from the past” (Merriam-Webster). You see, what my parents have left for me is a legacy of staying married, of working through problems, of suffering together through trials. It is a legacy of stability, of unity and of peace. It is a legacy of faith, hope and love. It is a legacy of love and respect. It is a legacy of family, of trust and of honoring God. My parents are leaving me a legacy of never accepting divorce as an option. It is a legacy of commitment, of keeping one's word. More than money or land or possessions, my parents' gift to me is a foundation for my own marriage, and (if we live long enough and Jesus hasn't returned) for my children's marriages. They have taught me how to lean on each other, how to lean on God, how to rejoice and how to be broken. They have shown me that love and marriage is sometimes messy, and that there is no such thing as a perfect relationship. Yet they have shown me that love is worth fighting for, and that having each other is sometimes the most precious of gifts.

It is a legacy 50 years in the making, and I am grateful to God for the gift my parents' marriage is. Until we meet again...TWP
