World Video Bible School Brings Interesting Conversion

In 1994, Thomas Siltz was working at the Medical College of the Georgia Public Safety Division when he noticed that there was a great need among the homeless and needy. He started street ministry but his Bible knowledge was limited.

From 2003 to 2005, Thomas J. Siltz attended the Trinity Evangelical Christian University to grow in Bible knowledge to help him be a chaplain. In 2004, however, he came across material from the [World Video Bible School](#) and began searching to find whether what they said was in harmony with the Bible. From 2005 to 2007, Siltz studied for the Priesthood at Agape Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky, preparing to be a priest in the Old Catholic Church. During this time, however, he began to find that he agreed more with the materials coming from World Video Bible School than with those views he was being taught in the seminary.

The World Video Bible School of Maxwell, Texas, is non-profit corporation connected with churches of Christ and has been operating since 1986. During these years they have provided over a million and a half audio and video materials to those who have requested them. Siltz particularly made contact with WVBS co-founder Church Horner for help in understanding more of the Bible teaching.

The more Siltz studied the WVBS materials and compared them to what he was hearing from his seminary and from other sources, he concluded that the World Video Bible School materials were in harmony with scripture. He was particularly impressed with the teaching that baptism was by immersion of those who were old enough to understand for themselves rather than the sprinkling or pouring.

He also learned that confession of sins is something we do with God rather than to a priest, that the Lord's Supper is to be celebrated on Sundays, and that singing in the early church, which should be our model, was without instruments.

In April of 2009, Siltz left the priesthood and on August 2, 2009 was baptized by immersion into the Lord's church.

Siltz now attends the [Brooks Avenue Church of Christ](#) in Raleigh, North Carolina, and believes that churches of Christ teach in harmony with the scriptures. He is involved there in their urban ministry.

This story teaches us that we need to utilize every way we can to get God's message to the world. For some, the best way is through audio and video materials. For others it is a personal contact or a home [Bible study](#). For others, it is public preaching or written materials that will most likely be the medium of most interest.
