CONSISTENT OR CONTRADICTION?

By now most of us know about one of the most recent battles in our culture war that involved actor Kirk Cameron.

The battle started a couple of weeks ago when CNN's Piers Morgan asked Cameron if he thinks homosexuality is a sin. Cameron replied, "I think that it's unnatural. I think that it's detrimental and ultimately destructive to so many of the foundations of civilization."

Of course, let me emphasize that his response was, as it always is, straightforward but not with an angry or incendiary tone. That's one of the things I admire most about him; he stands for the truth, but he presents it in such a way that people can only be angry with what he says, not with how he says it.

Well, as many of you know, his response sent the mainstream media and Hollywood elite into a frenzy. They tried to beat him to a pulp, figuratively speaking. He was laughed at, mocked, painted as out-of-touch with the times, insulted, ridiculed, and threatened. Earlier this week Cameron was a guest on the "Today" show, promoting his new movie, when he was once again asked about his comments on CNN concerning homosexuality. He said several wonderful things, but the thing that stuck with me the most was this:

I was surprised, frankly, that people were surprised by the things that I said, because I have been consistent for 15 years as a Christian; I'm a Bible-believing Christian. What I would have thought was more newsworthy is if I had said something that contradicted the Word of God - if I had contradicted my faith.

That statement made me think about myself and what God wants me to be. He wants me to be a consistent, dedicated follower. He wants me to live, talk, and work every day in a manner that is consistent with His Word, not culture. My hat goes off to Kirk Cameron for doing that in an industry that is far more hostile to Bible-believers than any industry in which any of us work.
