TIM TALK

He was *almost* dead. He had spent a week in the hospital with doctors trying to delicately balance kidney disease, diabetes and hypertension. He had been a patient patient, and it seemed that all his medications were synched with his body's processes. His first afternoon back home was a beautiful one. He spent time in his two-acre yard looking over all the azaleas in full bloom, the budded peonies and the box with six bluebird eggs in their nest. He ate a nice dinner and relaxed while watching a little sports action on TV. He stayed up a little later than his wife, but woke her a few minutes later when he came to bed, thankful to be in his *own* bed, for a change. As he lay down for a good night of rest he told his wife, "The Lord sure has blessed me." And those were *almost* his last words...ever.

Just a short time later he had slipped into a hypoglycemic coma. His blood sugar level had plunged to 40, his blood pressure was 90/40, his heart was beating around 40 beats a minute and his core temperature had fallen to 92 degrees. His body was shutting down. And he *almost* died. Thankfully, my mom awakened, discovered Daddy's condition and called emergency personnel to take him to the hospital. Over the next several hours, he hovered between life and death before stabilizing.

We all understand close calls. We talk often about near-death experiences; in fact, books abound that detail people's alleged trips to "the other side" and back. Yet we also understand that when you die, that's it. But it hasn't always been that way. At least not with God.

As you read through the pages of the Bible, you come across the stories of some eight specific individuals who were raised from the dead by someone else. We will be talking about some of them today. Yet there is one resurrection that stands out from the rest; it is different because no individual was involved as the agent of God's power. God simply breathed into him the breath of life... for the second time! The restoration was so powerful that many others were actually raised from their graves at the same time. It was announced by an angel. It was confirmed by many appearances on his "Back-from-the-Dead" tour. Eyewitness testimony was recorded. People could not believe what they were seeing.

But it should not have been a surprise. He had told people beforehand that, in fact, he *was* the resurrection. And his new life proved forever that God would keep his promises. Today, may you be blessed in being reminded of that assurance. Until we meet again...TWP
