"Pierced to the Heart" or "Cut to the Quick"?

In the Book of Acts, we will see many reactions to the Gospel message by those who hear it. We will see some who are "pierced to the heart" and will obey the Gospel. We will find some who are "cut to the quick" and became enemies of Jesus. Several years ago when I was in Ghana, West Africa, I was studying with several WBS students. We were sitting under a shade tree while pedestrians were walking by looking in on us. One tall man kept walking by every few minutes and he would stop and listen for awhile then walk off. After this happened several times, I ask him if he would like to sit down with us. He stated that he already went to church, but was wondering if we studied with people who were already members of a church. My answer, of course, was yes, we study with anyone who desires to sit and discuss God's Word. After studying with this man for several days, we took him out to the beach and baptized him for the forgiveness of sins. This man was willing to listen and obey what God said in his word. Ten years later when I went back to Ghana, the church that had been established on that first trip, invited me to come and visit with them. The man, who had been baptized, was now an elder in the Lord's church. He had grown in wisdom and knowledge of God's Word and was well respected by the brethren for his gentleness and care for people. He, had been "pierced to the heart" with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Another time I was studying with a young man and his wife, when they got up from the couch cursed at me and left the house. I do not know whatever became of them but they were not "pierced to the heart." Yet, I had preached the same message to both the Ghanaian and the young couple. Peter's message in Acts 2 pierced the heart of those who were listening. Then, in Acts 5:33 Peter spoke the same message and those in that audience were "cut to the quick" and intended to kill Peter and John.

Same message, different reactions. I wonder this morning how the message will be received. I wonder if anyone will be pierced to the heart. More importantly, will there be any who will be cut to the quick and want to kill me. Acts 3 starts the cycle of a drop in the popularity of the Gospel. Enemies align against the message and messengers of the Messiah. Some are going to be killed and some are going to become well known preachers for the Savior. I wonder how your response has been over the years to God's message...not the messenger, but the message. Is your heart pierced or cut to the quick?
