## MINISTER'S THOUGHTS

### No Other Name

I know that I have a unique name – Joe Boe! I had a lot of problems in elementary school over that name and consequently got into a lot of trouble. One of the unusual aspects of my name is that I am a Jr. and I am the second son in the family. Normally, the first son is named after the Father, but not in my case. I have no idea why my parents did this to me, but there you go. My mom says she was under sedation while they named me and my dad won't talk about it. So I have no logical reason or explanation as to why I have this name.

My name has caused me a lot of grief and a lot of jokes...go ahead, I've heard them all. For many years, I thought I must be the only person on this earth named Joe Boe, besides my father of course. I thought by going on-line, I would see how unique my name was, but it turns out that according to spokeo.com there are 57 Joe Boe's in the United States. There are 11 just in California. Then, Fredrick Goodrich tells me there is a country radio personality in the Fresno area named Joe Boe. Well, in spite of the other Joe Boes, I have had a lot of fun with my name over the years, once I grew up and quit hitting people for making fun of it. So, I am really not that unique, it is a little disappointing to discover you're not so "special."

I do want to tell of another name that is quite unique...Jesus Christ. Peter states in our passage this morning "there is no other name by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12). What an incredible revelation for the first century church. No other name! We now have over 6.8 billion people on this earth. I have no idea how many have ever lived. I suppose we could at least double the 6.8 billion and easily come up with about 14 billion. Yet, in all those people, all those names (including the Joe Boes), only one name will save us. That one name represents only one person, Jesus Christ the Nazarene. The first century church, revealed in the Book of Acts, turned the world upside down preaching just that one name. I am excited this morning to be able to also preach just that one name, no other will do, no other will save, and no other will turn our world upside down today.

Peter will also say in this text when he and John are told not to speak in His name again, "we cannot help but speak what we have seen and heard!" Wow! That name creates in the true disciple a craving for preaching the only name that will save. I love this job of preaching that one name – Jesus Christ.
