## GIFTS

*As each has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.*  
1Peter 4: 10

Whatever *gift*, is given to us, we should use that gift to minister to one another. Yes, everyone has been given gifts by God to share with others. It might be the gift of listening, or *not* judging...it could be that we have been blessed with an affinity to diagnose illnesses or fix automobiles or air conditioners. We may have the gift of having a "green thumb". Every one has some talent or characteristic, which can benefit another. When we use those gifts to enrich the lives of others, we carry out the two greatest commandments of God:

*"Love the Lord thy God with all your heart, soul and mind..."*  
*"...Love your neighbor as yourself."*  
**Matthew 22:37-39**

The *Gifts* handed down from God are for the benefit of others, not just ourselves. In our world today this teaching is completely backwards. We sometimes act as if the *gift makes us the important one; instead of God's intent that the gift is given to enrich the lives of others.* When we *give* that gift, we know that our Father in heaven will be pleased. Whatever we are called to do let it honor God and Christ His Son... let us *give* in His name. If we truly care for others, as believers in Christ, we *give* as we can and give God the glory.

The greatest gift God *gives* to us all is His Son; *Jesus The Christ*, for our redemption from sin.

## The Promise Of Eternal Life

**Medical science has accomplished amazing feats the last few years. In addition to enabling us to live longer through good nutrition, they have extended life through organ transplants. Life is so precious that most individuals do whatever it takes to extend his or her life.**

**No matter how long one lives on earth, it is short compared to eternity. John reminds us of a wonderful promise that Jesus made when he wrote, "This is the promise which He Himself made to us: eternal life" (I John 2:25). That eternal life begins the day one is born into the family of God through being immersed in water for the forgiveness of one's sins (John 3:1-8; Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38). Even though we will die physically, our soul doesn't have to ever die again. One of the great comforts of this verse is that the promise of eternal life comes from God who does not lie (Titus 1:2). Since God promised us eternal life, we know that He will give it to us.**

**But, God will not give it to us if we do not fulfill our part. John exhorts us, "Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming" (I John 2:28). This verse shows us that one must continue to abide in Christ.**

**The implication is that it is possible for one who has been baptized into Christ to quit abiding and therefore to be ashamed when Christ returns. There is nothing sadder than one who has been saved and who has begun his Christian walk, to fall away from it.**

**Let this short message motivate us to do two things: (1) Maintain faithfulness all of our life, (2) Do what we can to restore to faithfulness those of Christian who have departed from us and gone back into the world of sin. They need our help. You may be the very person who has the right connection with someone to bring him or her back to God.**

**If you have not been born into God's family so that you have that eternal life, let us assist you in doing that.**
