## TIM TALK

For the last two weeks, my parents were visiting with us from Tennessee. It was their first time to be in California, thus their first visit to Fresno and Woodward Park. Because they had never been here before, we wanted to show them some of the natural beauty of this state. We were privileged to travel with them to the Pacific coast at Monterey and Carmel. We took day trips into Yosemite and Sequoia/Kings Canyon National Parks. As we expected, they were impressed with the sights in each of those places. But what was more interesting to Dana and me was that, while we had seen all those sights before, we were just as awed by them as we were the first time. We soon found ourselves out of superlatives in trying to express the beauty of what we were seeing.

There is something almost hypnotic to watch the ocean's waves come crashing in to the rocky shore. There is a power that is both visible and felt in the cascading waters of Bridal Veil Falls or Grizzly Falls. That power was really brought to mind when watching the raging Kings River coursing through the floor of the canyon. The unbelievably blue skies were colored with indescribable shades of pink, orange and purple at sunset. Looking up at the high, snow-covered peaks of the Sierras truly helps you feel small, humbled.

Seeing these things brought some words from God to mind. "For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God" (Romans 1.20). "The heavens proclaim the glory of God. The skies display his craftsmanship. Day after day they continue to speak; night after night they make him known" (Psalm 19.1-2).

In other words, God designed the beauty of the outdoors to show Himself to me. Wow! God wanted me to believe in His eternal, creative power so much that He hand-crafted mountains and valleys, stars and moons, rivers and snow. Paul even says that God's nature is so visible in the created world that men who deny his deity or his existence really have no excuse. That's a pretty strong claim.

Despite the sudden arrival of three-digit, summer heat, get outside and look around. Take a drive with your family into the mountains. Look up into the sky at the cloud formations, the sun dogs or the palate of the sunset. See the hand of God, His power, His nature in those things. Then ask yourself, "If He did that for me, how much must He love me!" Wow, God...
