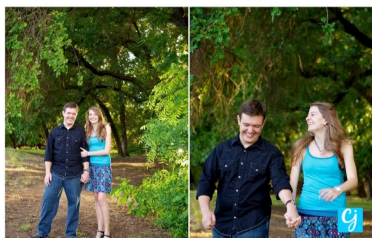

TIM TALK

As a kid, I attended Mid-South Youth Camp near Henderson, Tennessee. I do not recall how many years I went before "The Year." I was cursed as a kid by being one of the first ones asleep at night. Thus, I was the easy target for nighttime cabin pranks. That year was particularly bad. One night I was awakened to realize I had just smeared mentholated shaving cream in my eyes. I went crying to my counselor who sent me to the bathroom to shower in the middle of the night. Eyes still burning, I went back to sleep only to wake up a little while later with my eyes caked with mint toothpaste. It took a lot longer in the shower to get all that washed out. Once that week was over, I never went back to camp again.

That was the experience I brought with me to YBC last summer. And boy was I in for a surprise. Even as an adult staff member, camp was great! I got to be with my family on God's Mountain, I got to share in sweet fellowship with my brothers and sisters, and I got to spend an hour every day with a great group of teens.

So this year, preparation for camp was a lot less stressful. As I write this, I have already been blessed by being here and I know that the rest of my family could say the same. Our theme is "The Amazing Race," and we are focusing on our Christian walk as a race. I am again privileged to spend some time teaching the high school kids.
