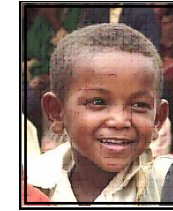
Lanette Andrist— My husband and I will be taking a vacation to Mexico this week. Please pray for our safety while in Mexico and a safe trip home.

CHANGE FOR CHILDREN



The "Change for Children" ministry started in March 2004. Over the years your contributions have been enough to fund the kindergarten in Shinshicho. This school educates 106 children each year free of charge. All the students are all from destitute families; the poorest of the poor. There is no Kindergarten program in the government school system. All other Kindergartens in Shinshicho are for profit private schools. Families of our students could not afford to pay tuition no matter how small the charges might be. After graduating from our two year program, our students enter the first grade in government schools. Before they are accepted, all first grade students must take an entry exam. Our graduates score much higher than students from other Kindergartens. This little girl is one of the students that your contribution supports. Her story is like most of our students. Let's meet her.



Her name is Sentayehu Haile Mariam. She is seven years old. When she was smaller, her father died. Her mother remarried and after the wedding, her step father refused to allow Sentayehu to live with their family. Her mother found relatives who were willing to

give Sentayehu a home. She has no brothers or sisters and has been attending our school for 2 years. Her teachers say she is a very bright student and participates actively in the classroom. She plans to go to the first grade at a government school next term. Her relatives are extremely poor and appreciate what our school has provided for Sentayehu. We believe she will one day be a dedicated Christian lady; perhaps the wife of a preacher.

If you would like to join us in educating and changing the lives of children like Sentayehu, take one of our "Change for Children" cans and start saving your change. Once every four months, you and your children can bring the cans to the front during our contribution worship period.
