Time Is: "Too slow for those who wait, too swift for those who fear, Too long for those who grieve, too short for those who rejoice, But for those who love—Time is not." Unknown

"There is a time for everything and a season for every activity under heaven." Ecclesiastes 3.1

How does one make good use of time? We know God created the heavens and the earth in six days and rested on the seventh...He used time wisely, so how about us?

The first step is to realize the brevity of life (time) and seek help to use it wisely. Secondly, assess the value we place on time and how we view it.

"...so teach us to number our days, that we may gain a heart of wisdom." Psalms 90.12

Moses' life (his time) was transformed by God, from caretaker of sheep to deliverer of His people . . . Boring? Not a chance. Between the ages of 40 and 80 Moses spent his time tending his father-in-law's flock of sheep in the desert. But then something happened and Moses' life was changed forever.

Moses hears God's call from the "Burning Bush" to be His messenger to the Pharaoh. He is transformed by God to be His spokesman. Moses delivers the Israelites by using the power of God; the plagues pronounced on the Egyptians, Passover instituted, and Pharaoh letting God's people go. Moses parts the Red Sea, he makes the bitter water sweet, he pronounced God's miracle of manna and quail from heaven to the Israelites, Moses stretches his rod over the battlefield and the victory over the Amalekites is won; he delivers the Ten Commandments; he pronounces God's displeasure of the Golden calf; Moses returns again from Mt Sinai with the Tables of Stone. The final chapter of Moses life (time) is on the Mountain with God, together they overlook Canaan and there God buries Moses.

Every life is time filled and every life is a pilgrimage. Every person is on a journey as was Moses. The journey has its challenges. Whether it is Moses or us, a pilgrimage exists. The trip from Egypt to the promised land can be made in nine days . . . It took the Israelites thirty-eight years. What they should have done they didn't and what they didn't do, they should have done. God decided they needed time to rethink their priorities.

Is time moving too slow or too fast on your pilgrimage? Maybe you've taken a detour and you can't find your way back. Before time, God was and after time, He Is. God is the Great I AM . . . Always in the present . . . God has no past or future; God is timeless, so take the opportunity He has given every man. Clutch His hand, respond in obedience and He will lead you through time to where He resides . . .and it won't be boring. He has promised!

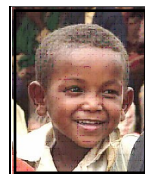
