With each day that passes, we feel more and more a part of the family of God here at Woodward Park. So many have done things to ease our transition, and so many have deliberately gone out of your way to make us feel as though we have always been here. One of the best ways that we can get to know each other is by spending time around the table. Several have already hosted us and more are scheduled over the next couple months, but we want to begin doing something a little different to bring you into our home.

We call it **Partake with the Parishes**. Here's how it works: Each month we will designate a day on which you will come to our house for dinner if you are married and it is the month of your anniversary or if you are single and your birthday falls in that month. If you are still in high school or younger, you will come with your parent(s) in their anniversary month. Doing this means that within one year, every person in the congregation has had the opportunity to be around our table. Most months, if you are financially able, we will ask you to bring specific items (sides, desserts, etc.) but sometimes it will be simple potluck. The sign-up sheet will usually have that information on it.

The first one of these will be this month, **September 27th** at 6:00 p.m. There is a sign-up sheet on the Welcome Center. If you plan on coming please sign up so that we can better prepare.

God tells us that we should be hospitable people, and to share with others the things with which He has blessed us. We think this is a way to do that, while getting to know our new brothers and sisters. Besides, we usually have a really good time eating, so it promises to be a fun, enjoyable night, too!
