Often, I will hear something or read something that just really gets my attention. Wednesday night, I had that experience in Matt Holcomb's class on 1 Peter. As I was comparing different translations of chapter 3, I went on into chapter 4, and came across this passage in a modern version called "The Message."

"Since Jesus went through everything you're going through and more, learn to think like him. Think of your sufferings as a weaning from that old sinful habit of always expecting to get your own way. Then you'll be able to live out your days free to pursue what God wants instead of being tyrannized by what you want.

"You've already put in your time in that God-ignorant way of life, partying night after night, a drunken and profligate life. Now it's time to be done with it for good. Of course, your old friends don't understand why you don't join in with the old gang anymore. But you don't have to give an account to them. They're the ones who will be called on the carpet—and before God himself." - 1 Peter 4.1-5
