This year Chen did not come to the U.S. for the Tahoe Family Encampment as planned. He decided to remain in Cambodia because they have begun English classes for the children in villages near the training facility. The children attend classes five days a week and it is important for him to keep their schedule constant since they are just beginning the English instruction.

The Bible classes are still in progress as well. The men study and learn how to teach then they return to their villages to teach. The schedule was slightly disrupted this summer when the van experienced some mechanical problems and they had to delay repairing it due to funds. But, it has been fixed and everything is back to normal.



Chen traveled to several villages in July to pass out school uniforms. The children are always very grateful to receive a uniform which allows them to attend school. REMEMBER to use your SHARE cards. You are doing a good job and the extra funds raised through this program allows us to do even more Humanitarian work than we could without these funds.

Sylvia and I attended the Tahoe Family Encampment and we were glad to see all of you who came by our booth. Thanks for supporting our booth and all the efforts for the work in Cambodia.

Our plans are to return to Cambodia in January 2012. Please continue to pray for this mission, especially through these difficult days ahead with the state of our great country. We have worked with the Cambodians here in Fresno for 12 years and with this mission for over 6 years. There have been huge changes in Cambodia with the rising cost of everything. We pray daily for this work and your prayers are needed that God's word will continue to be preached and His light will continue to shine ever brighter because of a caring people here in the States.
