Chen arrived in the United States on July 18th. We will be attending the Tahoe Family Encampment for a week. When we return to the Fresno area, he will be speaking at local congregations in August about his mission work in Cambodia.



The construction on the school at the new location is almost completed. We met on the second floor for Worship services while we were there in April. One of the first items that Chen wanted



completed was a place to baptize the new Christians. There were 18 people immersed for the forgiveness of their sins the first time we used the new baptistry. We ask that you pray for these new souls in Christ.



Two of the villages we visit while we are there have been using the property that Chen purchased for the church members to grow vegetables to help them be self-sufficient. The two girls are holding potatoes grown on the farm in Three



Mango Tree Village. This type of potato is called “tiger paws”.

On August 3rd four of Chen’s current students will begin teaching 24 other students the course “Discipleship I”. When Chen returns on August 23rd, he will continue teaching “Discipleship II, III and IV”.

We hope to meet new people at Tahoe who will be interested in partnering with us in this Great evangelistic endeavor. The Cambodian people are very responsive to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The potential of this mission is very promising. Please keep us in your prayers as we travel and that this work will continue to glorify God in every way.
