became available. It has a very nice building they can use for the Bible school. He acquired it all for the price of the land. The Lord continues to provide abundantly.

Currently there are fourteen men attending the Bible training school. The day Rick arrived Chen sent the students to their villages to continue to teach their families and neighbors. Chen and Rick spent the next day gathering school uniforms, food and medical supplies. After loading the supplies into the van, they left to visit the students in their villages. As they visited each location, they continued the Bible teaching which resulted in 158 baptisms in the 12 villages they visited. Several students



for several months. One of the students, Johan, baptized his wife, his mother and his father-in-law. It is so exciting to see these students impacting the lives of their neighbors, but especially their family members.

In one village in Svay Reing Province, only 3 miles from the Vietnam border, we had no place to baptize so Chen sent a couple of students to purchase a large clay pot for \$15 dollars. After about an hour they returned with our makeshift baptistery. They use these pots to catch rain water for drinking and cleaning during the rainy season.

Rick has recently returned from the annual trip to Cambodia bearing good news. Positive results from the Bible training school are becoming more evident. As you may recall, Chen had to move the facility just outside of Phnom Penh due to the rising cost of rent. He built the new facility pictured at the left, on land that he owned. In several villages there were school uniforms given to the children which enabled them to attend public school. A total of 120 uniforms, at a cost of five dollars each, were given away. This includes a backpack, sandals, shirt and shorts. The children that receive the uniforms are so thankful that

they now have a chance to attend public school. We see so many kids 8 to 14 years old that cannot read or write. Thanks to those who have contributed specifically to this very important endeavor. You are changing the lives of these children.



The new facility provides plenty of room for the local church that Chen has been establishing during the past year. The students assist with the services each week.



This mission is relatively young with a slim budget but the results from persistence and God's blessings are evident. We ask that you continue to pray
