Chen has completed building the facility for the school which also allows the men to live there while taking Bible classes and studying God's word. This is a real advantage to the program.

This year for the first time, Sylvia and I will be taking three Cambodians from our congregation with us when we go to Cambodia in February. Vin and Soy Kong, and Tek Soeun will see their country for the first time since they fled during the war. They will visit their villages of Three Mango Tree and Toul Mar Kol where Chen has converted their families and friends to Christianity.



They will be able to assist us by sharing in the joy of giving the children school uniforms that have been donated by many of you which makes it possible for those children to attend school for the first time. They will also participate in the food distribution at several of the villages. There's even more good news! Samrin Kong, the son of Vin and Soy has longed to go to Cambodia for several years. Once again prayers have been answered. He is attending Fresno State and

will be leaving for Cambodia in December with the Engineering Department on a project with "Engineers without Borders". They will be involved in several projects to improve some communities. They include electrical, LED lighting and water filtration. He plans to visit Chen at the school while he's there. Samrin has been active in our college class at Woodward Park led by Matt Phillips and Matt Beene who have encouraged him to become



more involved. Recently he taught the Cambodian Bible class on Sunday morning. Our goal has been that the young people would be able to teach others and have a connection to Cambodia.

We find these accomplishments of 2010 to be very rewarding. It has involved much hard work but the progress has become more evident each year over the past six years. We continue to see many choosing Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Even though baptizing some of the villagers may present a challenge, there is always plenty of ingenuity around to accomplish the task. Amazing what takes place when the desire is present. The lady to the right was so overjoyed at being emersed for the forgiveness of her sins.
