Introduction:

- I. LIVING WITH INTEGRITY GIVES CONFIDENCE TO LIFE.
 1. Confidence in prayer.
 2. Confidence in decisions.

- II. LIVING WITH INTEGRITY REQUIRES SEPARATION FROM THE WORLD.

 2. There will be joy in participation of the Lord's people in praise.
